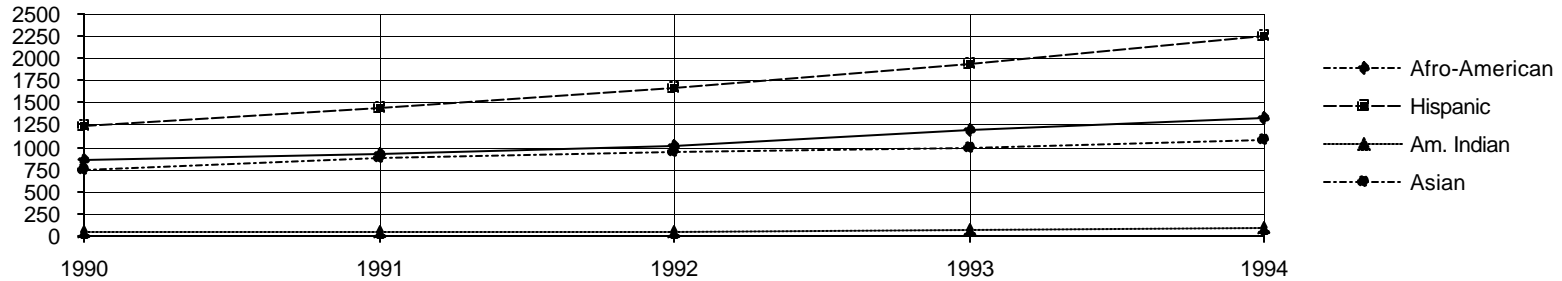

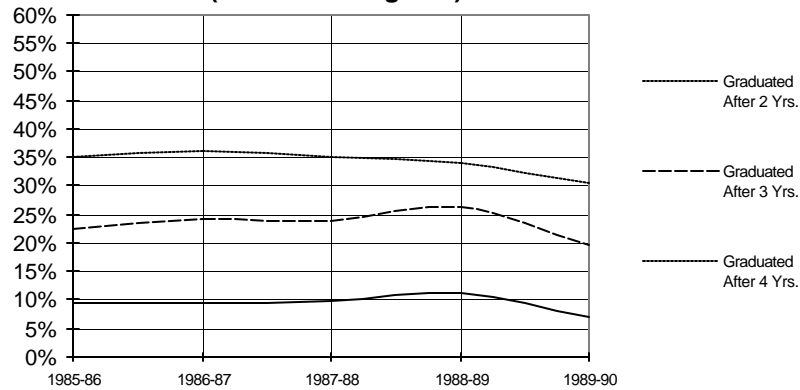

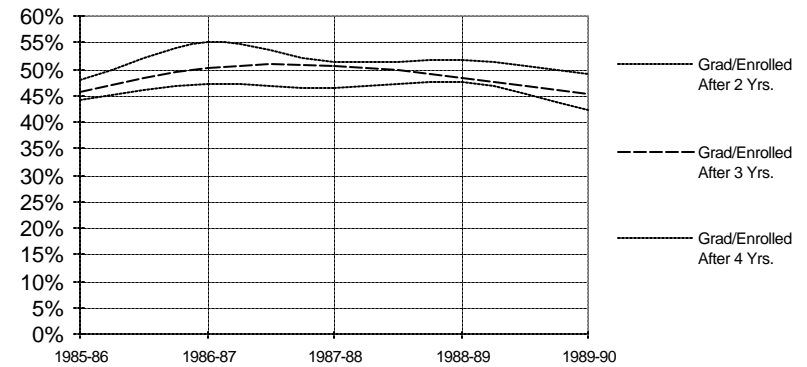

(No AA/AS Degrees) Graduated**



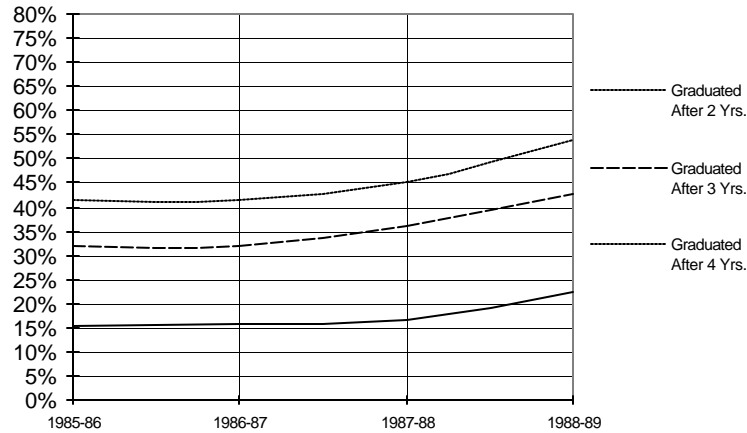
**FCC Transfers
(No AA/AS Degrees) Graduated or Enrolled**



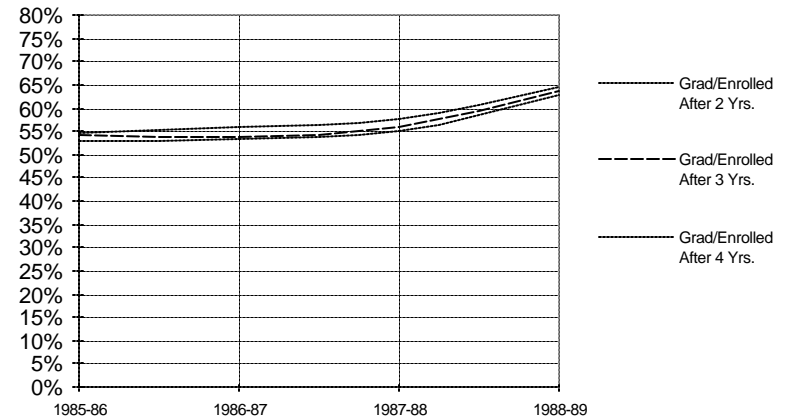

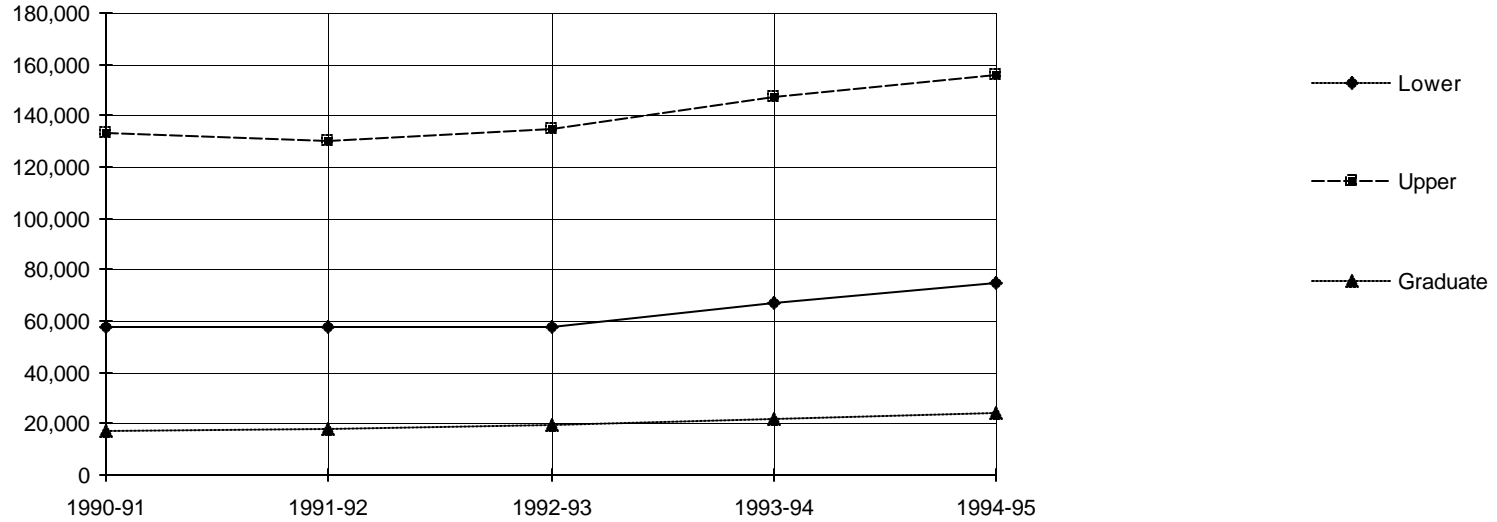

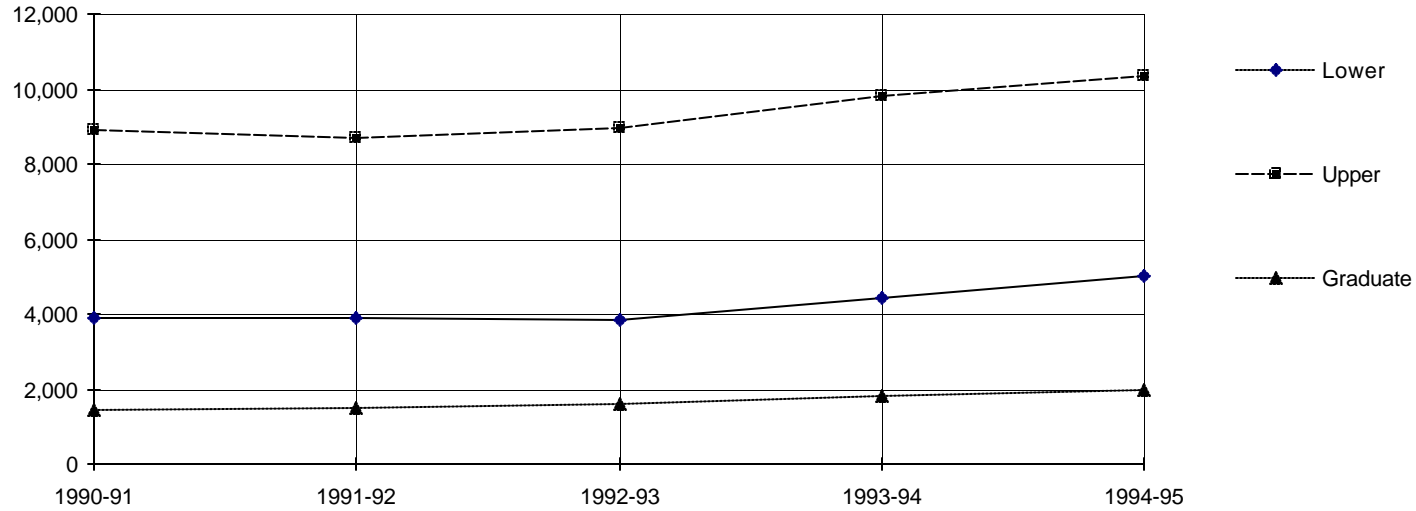

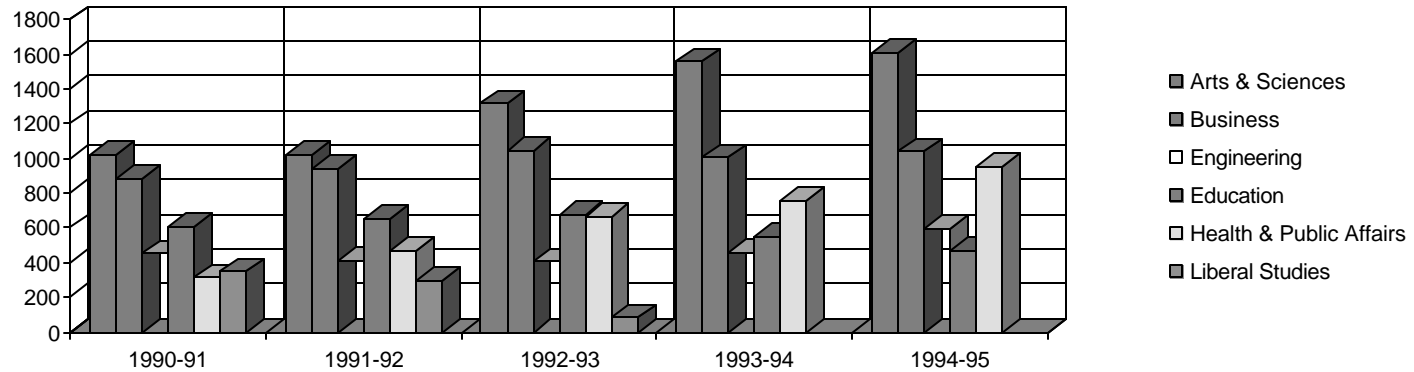

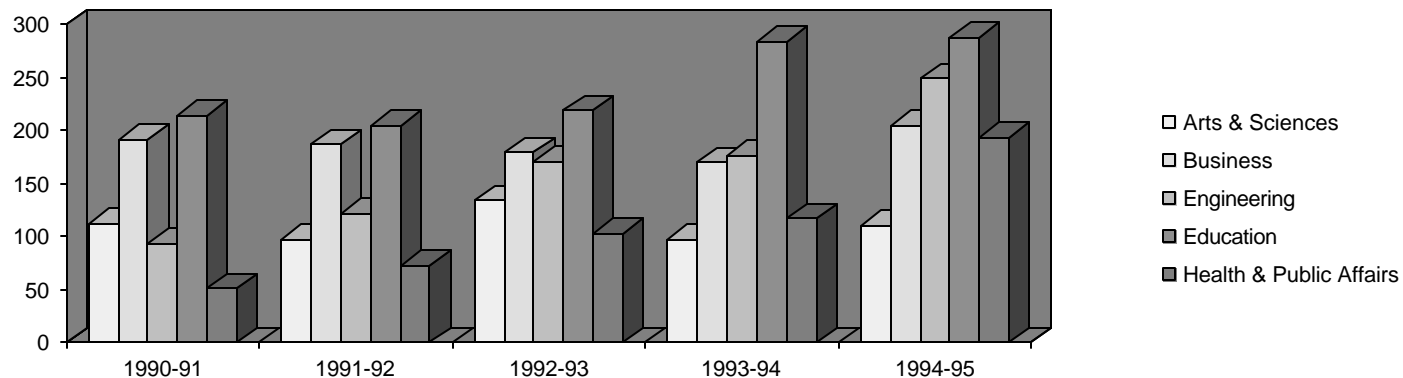

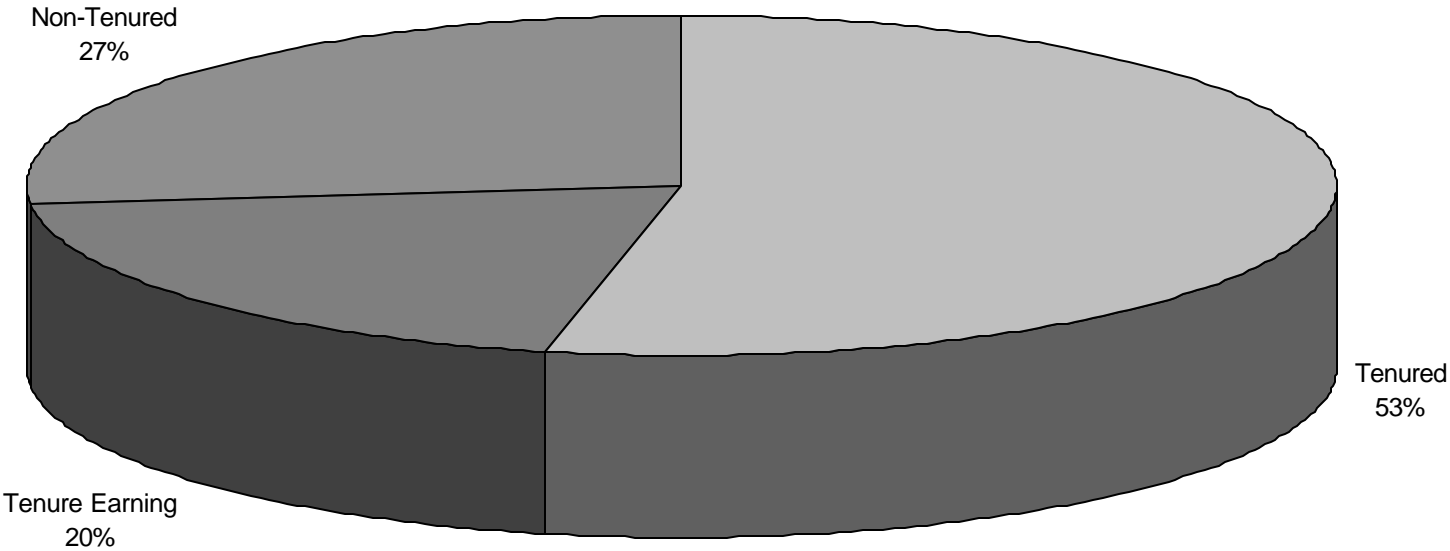
