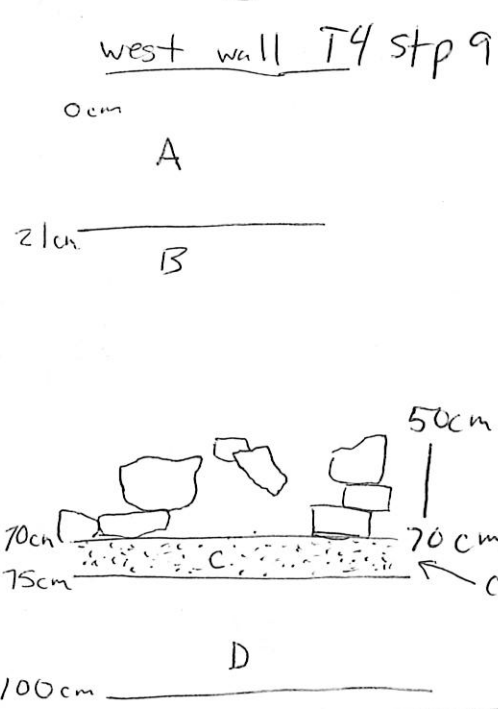

Notes:

- weather cool, but heavy winds. 40% chance of rain.
- Continuing testing of T4 - STP 9 - mostly shell & building debris, 1 square nail, some glass. Interestingly



@ 50-70cm is a layer of cleanly stacked brick debris, almost looked like a wall. Determined not a feature. This layer is directly above a layer of thick shell, w/ some brick pieces wrapped in the shell. Deposition must have been close together. But why? Brick in this debris layer most clearly seen in wall. Bricks are nearly intact (very large). No maker's marks thus far. Many pieces have a painted side (white).

STP 10 - 1 intact brick pulled out of S. wall @ ~20cmbs. No maker's mark. A few pieces of large, thick historic glass w/ Patina. Very little brick debris. No shell layer like STP 9 had.

- T4-STP 11 = sterile, completely sterile. T4 completed
- T5-STP 2 - sterile. Hit water @ 95cmbs.
- T5-STP 4 = 0-44 some small brick, concrete, & metal debris. Sterile after that. ~~STP 5~~
- T5-STP 6 - helped group 1 finish this until end of day
