B4 IS BISECTED WITH A WEST + EAST SIDE, WEST SIDE IS BEING REMOVED + SCREENED WHILE THE EAST PORTION IS GOING TO BE BAGGED FOR FLOTATION. FISH BONE WAS FOUND IN THE WEST MATRIX. THERE ARE DENSE ROOT INCLUSIONS IN THE FEATURE PORTION. THE DARKENED SOIL IS NOT VERY EVIDENT OR PRESENT IN THE WEST PART OF WHAT WE ASSUMED WAS THE FEATURE. THE EAST SIDE (MATRIX) HAD ~~SMALL~~ SMALL BONE FRAGMENTS.

THE FEATURE (B4) SEEMED TO DISAPPEAR IN THE SIDE PROFILE SO IT WAS NOT MAPPED. THE FEATURE/ SOIL WAS BAGGED DESPITE POTENTIAL DISAPPEARANCE.
