An Act to extend to the *British Colonies* in the *West Indies* an Act passed in the Fifth and Sixth Year of His late Majesty King *William* the Fourth, for regulating the Carriage of Passengers in Merchant Vessels. [3d July 1840.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Provisions of an Act passed in the Fifth and Sixth Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King *William* the Fourth, intituled *An Act to* 5 & 6 W. 4. *repeal an Act of the Ninth Year of His late Majesty, for regulating* c. 53. *the Carriage of Passengers in Merchant Vessels from the United Kingdom to the British Possessions on the Continent and Islands of North America; and to make further Provision for the regulating the Carriage of Passengers from the United Kingdom,* should be extended (except as herein-after excepted) to the Carriage of Passengers from Her Majesty's Dominions in the *West Indies* and *South America*, or from the *Bahama Islands*, or from *Bermuda*: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the said recited Act (except as herein-after excepted) shall be and the same is hereby extended to and shall be and the same is hereby declared to be in force in the *British Colonies*
