Have you used an **EBSCOhost Database** ([Academic Search Premier](#), [CINAHL](#), or [ERIC](#))? Did you know that you can create a **My EBSCOhost Account**?

An **EBSCOhost account** allows you to save searches, articles, and create search alerts! You also have the option of creating folders where you can save articles for projects. This feature is available in all EBSCOhost Databases. Next time you are searching an EBSCOhost database select "Sign into My EBSCOhost" at the top of the screen; then select "I'm a new user". Now each time you conduct research you can save your searches and articles, as well as create alerts to notify you when new articles are published on your topic. All of this information can easily be retrieved each time you login. For more information ask at the Research Assistance Desk or call/chat/IM with a Librarian!
