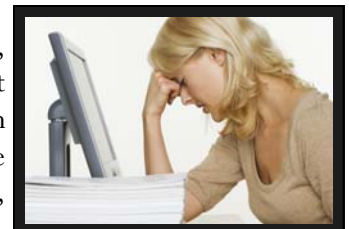
New Home Page
