high water at Buckingham next 4th day & [and] so dayly [daily] till [until]
I Come this Comes by the Governers. Smith & [and] I doubt will
not Come to hand untill [until] the first day next except
Abigaile [Abigail Pemberton] take care about it who has had the oppertunity [opportunity]
& [and] given me no account of your wellfare [wellfare] I am
indiferent [indifferent] well & [and] Long to be with thee [you] wch [which] I hope
will be ere [here] Long & [and] that makes the time more Long
untill [until] it Come, lett [let] George give the Cattle a small -
matter of hay In Cold mornings Let they shrink too
much on a suddane [sudden] I think thou [you] must hast [hasten] the death of
the Bullock he will shrink I Conclude as I usually [usually] do in
hast [haste] thine [your] in endeared Love
