Deare friend for the loving truth doo I most dearly salute thee
being glad towards of thy welfare as all the rest of my family are,
as myselfe p^p with the rest, & R^d Haydocks & one is allso to thee
who was here at a receipt of thine 26th of 11 mo: 44 my Mother also is
reasonable well, things relating to truth here awaye are well & in good
order blessed be the Lord for it, there is cleare opening in Cheshire
for the priests rage, John Chandy flees two againe by reason there
is a writt of Rebolian out agt him, soe & he is grimmish upon Ch^{ch}
alarmed, & is afraid of going to Lancaster & therefore flees into Cheshire
its thought by reason & severall friends are prisoners there to wit at
Lancaster, Mary Moss of manchester is detayed, this is the 3^d Letter
we have had from thee & from holland before & one from antwerp
first thou writt, we were not, but have bene glad of all & am now
understanding by them where thou was & & thou was well, & that truth
spred & progoe God, which thou knowest is desired by us, more then any
thing visible, p^p I did write a letter to thee some time agoe which it may
be thou may meet with, all thy relations are well for any thing I know
when thou hath an opportunity & etc know more pleribly of Ferris in
thy hands also thou may when thou comest down for I know thou
was straitned there in, in & I left before this & so on, I rememb^r
my Love to Bong: white head & his wife if may be & I may com
be a time called whitifunday if nothing prevent me, I yet know
not off, my wife p^p 14: & two Johns & John Clark rememb^r
theire deare Love to thee Allie Worthington is p^pretty well, soe is
I rest, but I have not seene her since I said him, but she hath often
bene Inquiring after thee, soe hath Geo: Hardman & others
my Mother & Love is to thee also, soe having little more to add
at p^p sent, but my in deard Love amongst the rest, in that
blessed truth, which never Changes, I rest thy & loving friend
& Brother in & blessed truth Ja: Harrison
