July 29th 1780

Phineas I have had a pretty good night & slept
very well. My water is broken extraordinarily
& I hope it will leave me but for the
present very much. I have not yet
to send by Anna: a card of black silk brocade but
no more but my love says all I love thy

from thy mother & sister
thou brother
