C A P. XLI.

An Act for further continuing so much of Two Acts, made in the Sixth and Thirteenth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, as relates to the opening and establishing certain free Ports in the Island of *Jamaica*.



WHEREAS an Act of Parliament was made in the Sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, (intituled, An Act for opening and establishing certain Ports in the Islands of *Jamaica* and *Dominica*, for the more free Importation and

Preamble.

Act 6 Geo. III.

Exportation of certain Goods and Merchandises ; for granting certain Duties to defray the Expences of opening, maintaining, securing, and improving, such Ports ; for ascertaining the Duties to be paid upon the Importation of Goods from the said Island of *Dominica* into this Kingdom ; and for securing the Duties upon Goods imported from the said Island into any other *British* Colony ;) which was to continue in Force until the First Day of September, One thousand seven hundred and seventy-three, and from

thence to the End of the then next Session of Parlia-
ment; and which, by another Act, made in the Thirteenth
Year of His present Majesty's Reign, was amended,
and such Parts thereof as relate to the said Island of
Jamaica were continued until the First Day of Novem-
ber, One thousand seven hundred and seventy-four, and
from thence to the End of the then next Session of Par-
liament: And whereas the further Continuance of the
said Acts, so far as the same relate to the Island of Ja-
maica, will be highly beneficial to the Trade and Manu-
factures of this Kingdom; may it therefore please Your
Majesty that it may be enacted; and be it enacted by
the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Ad-
vice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal,
and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled,
and by the Authority of the same, That the said Acts,
and every Thing therein contained, so far as the same
relate to the said Island of Jamaica, shall be, and the
same are hereby further continued, until the First Day of
November, One thousand seven hundred and eighty, and
from thence to the End of the then next Session of Par-
liament.
