NEWS YOU CAN USE FROM YOUR UCF LIBRARIES

Welcome Back Students!

Important Facts to know as you start the Fall Semester:

1. Your UCF Card is also your **Library Card!**
2. **Computer availability** is listed on the library home page—access this information from any computer!
3. **Group Study Rooms** are available (first-come, first served)—Ask at the Circulation Desk!
4. A self-guided **tour** of the library is available near the Research Assistance Desk (main floor)!
5. **Printing** is available from ALL computers; print stations are located on the 2nd & 3rd floors!
6. **Laptops, Netbooks, and iPads** are available for check-out—Ask at the Media Desk (3rd floor)!
7. **Photocopy machines** are located on floors 1, 2, 3 and 4 (color copier is on the 2nd floor)!
8. A browsing collection of **popular books & audio books** are shelved in the café area!
9. You can **chat, text or IM** with a librarian - try it from the computers in the library!
10. Be sure to register your laptop for **wireless internet access** to UCF!

Need Research Assistance?

The UCF Library Reference Department offers a **Research Consultation Service** for students, faculty, and staff of UCF. This is a customized, one-on-one meeting with a librarian with subject expertise within your research area. You will have the opportunity to discuss your topic in-depth with a librarian, who will offer advice as to what library resources will aid you in your research. We can advise you on choosing appropriate resources, picking search terms, developing a search strategy, as well as alternative document retrieval methods.
