 eternall Love and Life, springs in my heart
 towards thee at this time, as it hath often
 done when absent in Bodoy yea present in
 spirit, and in the stormes of my fathers Land
 of our Imbroage thee, who is our Rocks Life and
 Foundation, upon which we are built, and
 preserved, unto this day, blessed be the name
 of the god of heauen, faith my soule for ever
 the truth is my life, and the life of all gods
 people, and there yea and joy in the holy
 ghost, for the Lord hath chosen us to beare a
 testimony for him in his eternall power that
 is over all blessed for ever, and in that I dearly
 salute thy wife, with my friend Phineas and
 his wife, and all the family to Ellys wor-
 thington to all friends who may inquire after
 me, I am well ever way, blessed be the god
 of my salvation for ever, I have been writing to
 the justices. I do in a haste to send thee copies of
 them, I have been writing to friends in Ireland and
 to London and Holland, though I did write to thee
 twice or thrice before, and gave some account of that
 service that I had with the justices when I was
 committed, and for all things shall work to gather
 for good to them that love the god, for the Lord keep
 all friends Love, in their habitation, that the all
 may be met with the dew of heauen, while the
 stormes fall upon the hills, friends may rest
 in yea, and praise the Lord, who hath prospered
 over all blessed for ever
 my fellow prisoners
 there Love to thee
