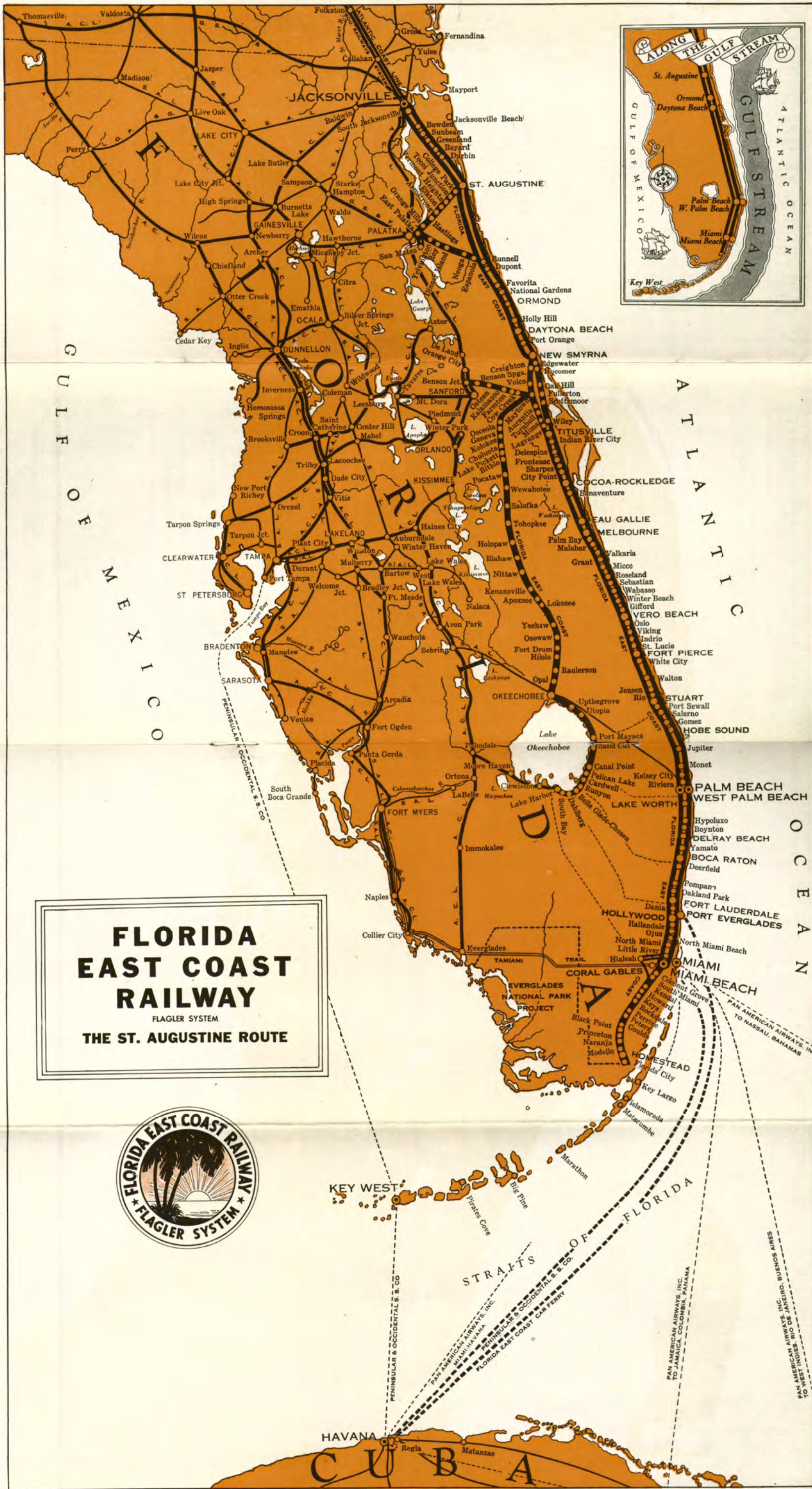

A—Regular Agency station. N—Agency station with twenty-four-hour service. F—Flag stop; trains stop only on signal, or to let off passengers.

Southbound trains **WILL STOP** at stations opposite which no time is shown **ONLY** to allow passengers holding tickets issued at Jacksonville and points north to detrain, **PROVIDED** the desired stop is the destination of the ticket sold.

Note 1—ST. AUGUSTINE is railroad station for Anastasia and St. Augustine Beach. Note 2—BUNNELL is railroad station for Flagler Beach. Note 3—PORT ORANGE is railroad station for Ponce Park and Wilbur-by-the-Sea. Note 4—NEW SMYRNA is railroad station for Coronado Beach. Note 5—TITUSVILLE is railroad station for De Soto Beach and Titusville Beach. Note 6—COCOA-ROCKLEDGE is railroad station for Audubon, Banyan, Canaveral, Courtenay, Cocoa Beach, Georgiana, Indianola, Lotus, Merritt, Orsino and Tropic. Note 7—MELBOURNE is railroad station for Melbourne Beach and Indialantic-by-the-Sea. Note 8—VERO BEACH is railroad station for Riomar. Note 9—FORT LAUDERDALE is railroad station for Port Everglades.

BAGGAGE MARKINGS. All baggage to be transported under check should be plainly and substantially marked by some device or color design, including the name and address of the owner. European travelers realize the satisfaction and comfort of that custom.

BAGGAGE MAXIMA. No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight, or 72 inches in greatest dimension, or single shipments exceeding \$2,500.00 in value will be checked.

BAGGAGE INSURANCE. Passengers have the privilege of declaring the value of their baggage with the idea of having the carriers assume a greater liability than \$100 provided for in the ticket contract. The charge for this insurance is 10 cents for each \$100 of increased value.

BAGGAGE CHECKED TO NON-AGENCY STATIONS. When baggage is forwarded under check to a station where an agent will not be on duty upon the arrival of this particular train, it must be claimed at the baggage car door immediately upon arrival at that station. Otherwise it will be carried to the first station where agent is on duty and held for further advice.

BICYCLES, BABY CARRIAGES, CRIBS or PLAY PENS, GO-CARTS, VELOCIPEDES and TRICYCLES are now transported in baggage cars as a part of free baggage allowance.

LOST ARTICLES. For articles left in Pullman cars communications should be addressed to the Superintendent of the Pullman Company at Jacksonville, Fla. However, inquiries addressed to the General Passenger Agent of the Florida East Coast Railway at St. Augustine will be given prompt attention. No responsibility is assumed for articles left at station or in coaches.

SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT NOTICE. The Florida East Coast Railway assumes no responsibility for inconveniences or damages resulting from delayed trains, errors in time tables or failure to make advertised connections. The schedule figures shown herein are accurate only in so far as the human agency may reasonably be expected to achieve.

CHILDREN. For children under five years of age, when accompanied by parent or guardian, no charge will be made.
For children five years of age and under twelve, the charge will be on the basis of one-half of the regular fare for an adult person.

For children twelve years of age and over, full fare will be charged.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS. Unused tickets will be redeemed under current regulations which provide for proper deductions in case baggage

current regulations which provide for proper deductions, in case baggage has been checked, or the ticket partly used. Upon application to the local

has been checked, or the ticket partly used. Upon application to the local agent a form will be supplied which must be filled in; or, communications addressed to the General Passenger Agent at St. Augustine will be given prompt consideration.

ADJUSTMENT OF DIFFERENCES. In case of disagreement with an Agent or Conductor as to the proper amount to be collected, we ask that the passenger make payment in accordance with the demands of the

employee, and take a receipt dated and signed. The question should then be referred to the General Passenger Agent at St. Augustine who will give it prompt attention.

STOP-OVERS. One-way tickets are limited to 30 days, in addition to date of sale, and stop-overs at intermediate stations are allowed upon application to Conductors.

TICKETS WILL NOT BE SOLD to crippled persons or those who are

too ill to adequately care for themselves, unless accompanied by a competent person in charge; to persons who are intoxicated or whose conduct might be a source of annoyance to other passengers, or who might be inclined to disregard the admonitions of members of the train crew.
