Philadelphia of 26<sup>th</sup> of 7<sup>th</sup> mo: 86  
Dear and loving friend after my love  
remember to thee and thy wife this  
is to let thee understand that we have  
finished our work at 7<sup>th</sup> mill these 70  
weeks ago and we are not paid it to our  
great prejudice for there is no coin in  
Cincinnati now <sup>but</sup> ~~but~~ this great  
while ago there <sup>was</sup> ~~was~~ some <sup>money</sup> ~~money~~ <sup>to</sup> ~~to~~ take  
paid in one thing or another that we  
may appear of workmen which keeps a  
good deal to do at us: we <sup>are</sup> ~~are~~ <sup>not</sup> ~~not~~ fair to pay  
them money because we had not <sup>money</sup> ~~money~~  
for them therefore desire thee to pay  
us in English goods ~~or in money~~  
if thou wouldst know what our work  
comes to it is 25 pounds or there abouts  
no more at present <sup>but</sup> ~~but~~ <sup>that</sup> ~~that~~ <sup>we</sup> ~~we~~ <sup>desire</sup> ~~desire~~ thee to  
send me an answer by J<sup>r</sup> Beaver fail  
not pray thee
