## Interlibrary Loan, Document Delivery Services, & **UBORROW**

**Interlibrary Loan (ILL)** is a free service to all UCF faculty, staff and students. UCF Libraries will borrow materials that it doesn't own from other libraries.

Faculty are eligible for **Document Delivery Services**, in which the UCF library pulls books and scans articles that are owned by the library. These services include the following:

- All articles owned by the UCF Libraries in print or electronic form will be scanned and delivered to your ILLiad/UBorrow account as an easily-downloadable PDF.
- All books, CDs, DVDs, and VHS tapes owned by the UCF Libraries will be pulled from the shelf and left for pickup at the Circulation Desk. <http://library.ucf.edu/ILL>

## Acquisitions & Collection Services



The library will maintain the collection in support of the university's mission to provide comprehensive teaching, research and service. Any faculty member may recommend materials by sending their recommendations to their faculty library liaison or to me as the Engineering and Computer Science subject librarian.

Each engineering department has a budget ranging from **\$3,150—\$4,000** to spend on monographs, e-books and AV materials this year. UCF libraries has about 35,000 journal titles. Faculty may recommend subscription to any journal titles. Due to budget restrictions on reoccurring materials, the library will evaluate each journal request.
