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Dublin Dec 27<sup>th</sup> 1680

Dear

Wife & truly beloved, how by thou mayest know by: I am well  
I had 500 the goods I took with me to the Atterton the former  
Small offit, & had intentions home ward this week, but this day  
I saw a letter from on with mather's name forgained  
Came to that Turner's dox say that he heard last 2<sup>nd</sup> day  
George Haydock was so ill at Carrick vergus he woud not recover  
where upon he & 2 other friends went to visit him, & dox say  
he is better & hopes he may get through it, I have proly  
must desire to see him, it may be I may go this week (I about  
do miles from this place) to visit him, however I shall not make  
absolute conclusion, I hope may have something from <sup>him</sup> post to  
morrow, & then may better know what to do, but if I go abroad  
at my return, if I be well & nothing prevent me I know not of  
to get home wards as soon as wind & shipping permits, therefore  
do not write after this comes to thy hand, I have not  
any letter from thee at yet,

Dec 27<sup>th</sup> 1680

The bearer not going away when he might give me the more  
time for finishing my letter, this day there is no letter com'n  
from George Haydock nor friends there away wch makes us hope  
he will make but short stay after he is removed (as I believe  
about) it woud be a great disappointment my dear love to see  
thee & father in law & mother & little ones Anne Abigail & the  
rest of the family & to friends in general, so I & his  
wife when thou sees them George Longworth cannot get a  
hour else woud be for going shortly ~~to~~ (towards our  
dear friend L.H.) it dears love to to you all & friends of  
our meeting, as soon as I can I will come home wards as  
a soon but woud be fuller satisfied about L.H. afore I come if  
possible, I have not else to add but that I am thy truly  
loving husband

John had from Bolton

Geo Atterton & Longworth  
landed here 6<sup>th</sup> day last &  
if I stay till beginning of  
the next week am in hopes of their company back

this is 2<sup>nd</sup> letter the first from post
