Dublin the 9th mo 1780

Dear ly belov'd let that by James Lumsd Mary
Battersby brother should mirary, I do here by
acquaint thee that our dear friend Roger
may look it fallen the spectacle at Carrick vogue &
do suppose it the first because he had it when
in this city it begun on him when he was not
well where of I acquainted thee in my no 11 post
he was so ill it was so he was not recover but
since then some friends have been to visit him
from about Lurgan & do write the hope he may
get through it, I had & have a desire to see him
but because we had not letter this day I post it
thought he may recover therefore questionable whether
I may find him if I should go I think begining of the
next week to be the out side of my stay but if
wind & shipping serve & I do not go to work it
I have done my business all ready, not this but am
thine in true love
leave love to father's mother little ones & friends
& I love it to you
write none after this comes to thy hand
thine the 3
