thee, leave by thou may know G. I am well & had been  
wif thee ere now I believe but that I have after  
I write my last to thee that George Haydock was  
ill & when upon I went down into the north & met  
wif him, coming towards Dublin & it now freely  
well recovered but had been much out of order  
had had a fever wif not get away this week  
the wind being altogether contrary & George until  
yester day, & George not being willing to come forth  
until first day was over I suppose not being alto-  
gether clear of the city, & wif not intend to get  
forth until this next week but if wind & shipping  
permit to believe we shall get away 2<sup>d</sup> day about  
noon & he being so near & wif was very unwill-  
ing to come wif out him but after first day do  
not intend to slip any opportunity for I want to be  
wif thee my dear, I have ~~the~~ no letter from the  
but one wif came & post being write afore thou  
had ~~the~~ any from me, I have love to father's &  
to mother & little ones, & the rest of the family  
Salute wif my love, I have not thy word, but that  
I am thine in endless & free love  
I have love to friends
