To: Friends James Harrison

After my kinde love to thee thy wife and family those may acquaint
thee, I formerly desired of thee to receive and to take possession
for me from John Edmonson Junr. Eighteen hundred Achers of
Land On Murder Creek: & Bill of Sale for y^e same from thee
a copy of and take out the power of Attorney to Demand
the same, y^e was also mentioned in y^e same power One
William Berry as promisor, a man of known Repute
as I am informed by y^e Edmonson desired thee to
assist thee, for he is a friend unknown to me, & as yet
have never writ to him, but now heere is a Bill enclosed, for him
w^{ch} desired thee to come to him by y^e first opportunity
I sent thee On my Own Aunt M^{rs} James Thomas six shillings &
four Large Bar Rum: and flower Bar of matts w^{ch}
I hope thou hast sold before now and sold to my Lontons
Lum now is sold here for 15^s a Gall, I purpose to send thee
Moor of our Country good w^{ch} 2^d & 3^d monthly in order to
have Money against I come for y^e party w^{ch} will be
wth Gods Assistance y^e next fall, formerly desired thee
to take in y^e Lot of Land bought for me in the City w^{ch} if not
I can pray for it soon and thy Charge On y^e or any thing
Else On my Acc^t shall be Allowed thee By thy Loving
