To: Friends & Family in Barbadoes ^{the 2^d} 3rd month 1688

Ann. Harrison. Friend. I Received dated
the 5th of 10 month 87. concerning the money
that is due from the estate of the
deceased husband. and according to the
order. I have ordered my Friend
Samuel Carpenter. to Retour: onto
you what is convenient in that matter
and have also sent him a copy
of the husband's account & last will
that I may have it in Bisquet and on
Corns. that stand on money as you can
a good. because I am unwilling to put
the money to the use of a little of money
only desiring what is my just due. which is
all at this time only the 2^d pound to
me. I bid thee farewell & Rest thy
Friend.
