my charges I will Allow thee, and if none here in word
get satisfaction until thou hears further from me, will
sit down to my profit and my Lot of Land in the
towns I desire thee pale in and my wife Records as
it is all in my name I hope if God will to be in
go party a while the next fall will go into to please
my self in the purchase of a small plant, but I
hope my Request to thee in this Letter is already
fulfilled, if not pray to be Expedient as possible
for the Accomplishment of the same for thy
