when thou see by Consideration or to what say
thou will only thy Company I desire and
price shall not break up off Let me hear
from thee as soon as thou has opportunity
and I will get my house ready for thee
I got J. Owen for my Neighbour in
the Layntoo adjoining to my Costs, we are
in great hurry. The privateers who broke
Prison are gone; Charles Goff was stabbed
last night by a Frenchman who fled for
the Murder. I am in great haste
