Brighouse the 29 of the 8 month 1697

my dear friend Phineas Pemberton this is to let thee know that John Bowne ordered an other friend to pay thy father in law and thy father turned it to an other sponson to be received upon thy fathers account as thou may plainly see by his own letter so that hee sayes howe ever draw d spill on mee therefore I doe intreat thee to make diligent inquiry for to know whether thy father had that money to paye again or not which hee turned over to thy later man to receive it upon thy fathers account and if it stad good then it is legall for thee to pay mee soe if desire thee send it by my friend william Ellis if thou find it to the contrary thou may send it in writing to mee this from thy friend and soe I rest Abraham Dgden

now phineas of Josice thee set my case as if it were thy own case I left with william nobelke about seven pound 5 shillings & 6 pence & with John Bowne about 2 pound & 2 shillings & 6 pence besides 6 shillings more which made it up ten pound 4 shillings; and that 3 pound thy father in law had for mee was all that would be granted; but that our dear friend Thomas musgraves went over into that Countrey & intreated william nobelke upon my demand & got sum more soe that I have received 3 pound 4 shillings soe that 39 shillings which thou should send mee will but be about thy own halfe if thou find it legall soe to doe soe in that love which neither length of time nor distance of place can separate us from through Jesus Christ our lord soe be it
