I have here enclosed sent a letter good hand conveyed to Philadelphia by the first convenient & Carefull opportunity, Abigail & priss had got the thing I have sent to gratify you for some thing for it and ordered him to send ^{it} to Joseph ~~at~~ to be left at him at Sants Youngs when it comes do thou take some of it or the most part of it for thy self Sarah & nancy & send some part of it here for priss & abigails its to be a little of it rubbed in the hams & in the hollow of the arms going to bed at a night & keeps warm hands a Cure of taking cold after it

Thou needs not to put those letters into the post office until he ~~returns~~ ^{comes} from York and had been at Philadelphia in order to make his return ^{back} for York & let them be conveyed until then & it may be I may be at Town ere the post return for York next time but if I should not be there before then send them away

thy dear Love & remembrance thy true friend

When the post comes upon my letter that its with it & see what gratify writes & if any bags come with it be careful they be not mislayd until I rowd downe
