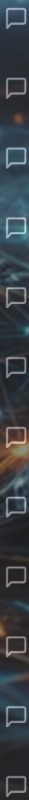

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The Prompt Template

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The Template is a combination of a "zero-shot" and "one-shot" prompt.

The Prompt is primarily a zero-shot prompt because it relies on detailed instructions and context-setting to guide the AI, without providing specific examples. The detailed structure and role-based instruction add elements of a one-shot approach by clearly defining the task in a comprehensive manner.

- 1. Zero-Shot Prompt:** This type of prompt doesn't provide examples but instead gives detailed instructions on the expected task. The Template includes the role, context, and tasks for the AI without giving specific examples of the desired output.
- 1. One-Shot Prompt:** This type involves providing one example along with instructions. The Template does not give any examples but it does offer very detailed instructions and expectations, which serves the same purpose.

This first direction sets the stage and type of AI that you are looking to work with.

- The type of prompt structure is called a "**role-playing prompt**" or "**persona-based prompt**."
- This approach assigns a specific role or identity to the AI, guiding it to respond as if it were an expert in a particular field or had certain experiences.
- By setting a clear context and role, it helps tailor the AI's responses to meet specific expectations and provide more relevant and targeted information.

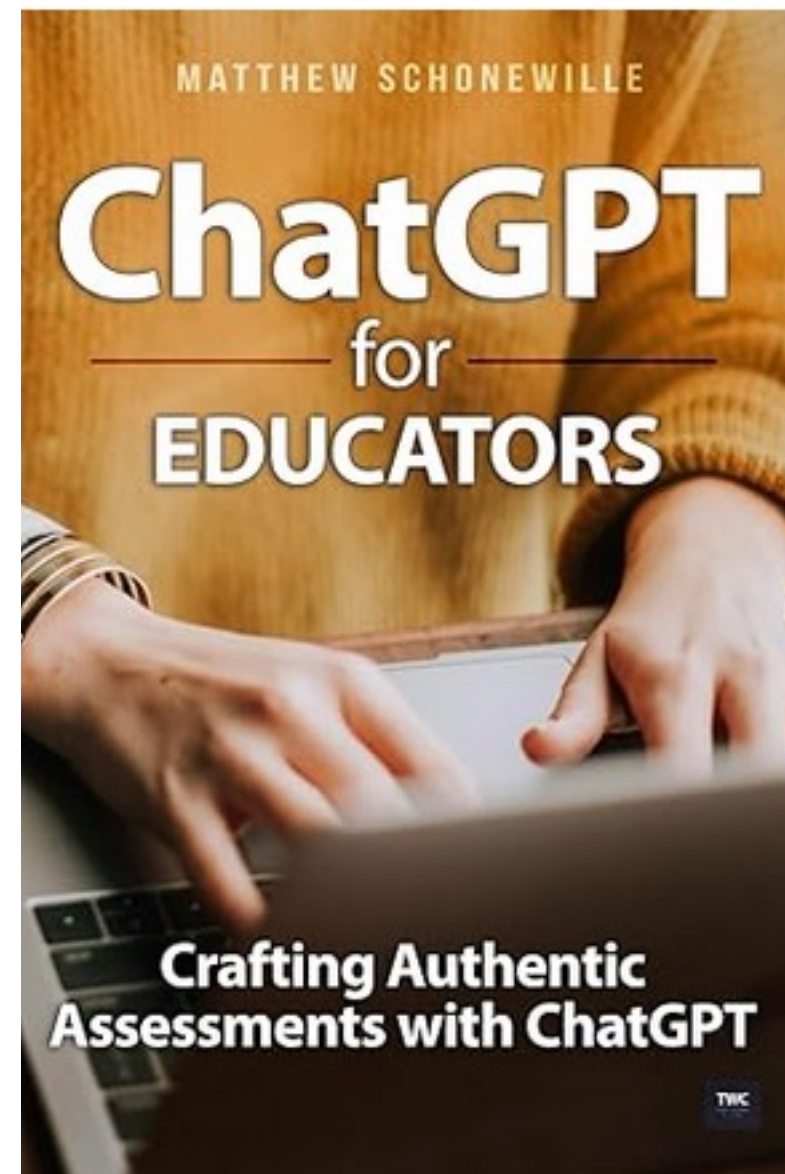
