you have bene, god almighty continue the same, while y<sup>e</sup> see and  
moore endure, amen, by those thou may know y<sup>e</sup> we are all  
Indefrunt well, and y<sup>e</sup> was at west Chester when thy letter came  
to Boulton, whither my wife sent it me, but I thinking it wold absend  
longer dare you had reached London, did not writ from thence for  
which I have bene troubled, I cast thoughts be straitned, for thy  
money, for I heard before I gat home from Chester y<sup>e</sup> you had som  
to London, remember my soniall love to Rodger whom I esteem, &  
honour in y<sup>e</sup> Lord, & tell him y<sup>e</sup> Elmor son, I am about to bargain  
for my house, in case I shoud goe with W: son, I doe not question  
but shew will aske his advise & I wold not have him to hind<sup>r</sup> his for  
wold have it p<sup>r</sup>posed for y<sup>e</sup> Lord's service, for I doe not question but our  
lovely money will be off for when we are gone, well dare Rodg I have  
heard and written sent thee anote or bill on William Gibson to whom my love  
is very large, either today or tomorrow I goe towards y<sup>e</sup> quarterly  
meeting, which will be at Lancaster, p<sup>r</sup> thebe I am y<sup>e</sup> whole family, I  
is to you, we have bene pretty quiet this great while, y<sup>e</sup> conspable gods  
out tomorrow, they have carried full better than like, before I could  
I desire thee put Susana Milner in my mind, often wishes her, whose service to y<sup>e</sup> servants of god, is well respected,  
accepted of god almighty, & I be like of all y<sup>e</sup> have heard of y<sup>e</sup> same, and  
love y<sup>e</sup> prosperaty of truth, thus in y<sup>e</sup> same love y<sup>e</sup> ever I love thee I shall
