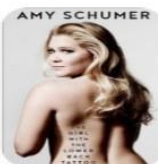
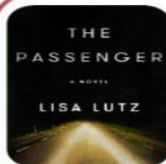

The 21st Century Library Project has begun.

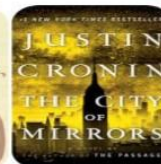
Site preparation has begun for construction of the Automated Retrieval Center (ARC), an exciting element of Phase 1 of the project. The ARC will make 1.25 volumes available for immediate retrieval.



Other elements of Phase 1 include conversion of the fifth floor to a new quiet study area, more electrical outlets, fire and safety improvements including renovated stairwells and sprinklers throughout the building, accessible restrooms, and upgraded elevators. Future phases of the project include construction of a building that connects the ARC to the

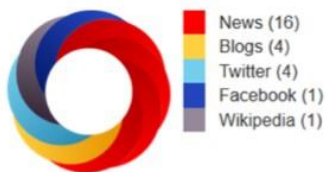

library building, and a complete renovation of the existing library buildings, as well as more group study rooms, as well as graduate student space, a reading room atop the ARC, a digital commons, 3,264 seats in varied types for individual and group study, expanded special collections and exhibits area, and a new main entrance on the Student Union side of the building. Library services and resources will remain available throughout the project. Space will be available for study and research in the John C. Hitt Library during all phases of work. Access to some areas of the Library will be restricted at times as the work proceeds, but alternative locations in the library for services and individual and collaborative work will be made available.
