## Web of Science Citation Connection

With the **Citation Connection**, we now have full access to all resources currently offered on Web of Science platform, which already hosts the existing UCF subscriptions to of Core Journal Citation Indexes (i.e. Science Citation Index, Social Science Citation Index and Humanities Citation Index), Incites (JCR) and BioSIS. Content Resources. Added with **Citation Connection** include:

- Data Citation Index (DCI) – 1900-Present
- Derwent Innovations Index (DII) – Patents Database – 1963-Present
- Book Citation Index: Scholarly Books, 2005 – Present
- Conference Proceedings Citation Index: 1990 – Present
- Index Chemicus (IC) – 1989-Present
- Current Chemical Reactions (CCR) – 1993-Present
- Current Contents Connect (CCC) – 1998-Present

**Citation Connection** will expand UCF's access to citation indexing to research that were historically difficult to track, particularly on citations to books, conference proceedings, data and patents in both the deep archival and current files.
