and well being the Lord continue it, I have spoken  
with will. y<sup>e</sup> m againe and will. Gibson on y<sup>e</sup> kinde  
at home, and he will perform what he hath said  
if the Lord bring him. I knowe for that he did not to  
quiesce any further will. Gibson has entered 25  
more, I am now ready to take shipping this  
evening at the tower in a Dutch shippe with a  
Dutch frigate, I have beene with G. H. this day  
and many friends taking leave with them, for  
that I have not time to say much, meetings and  
ginal and friends are well for with my love  
to thy dear wife y<sup>e</sup> kindeas y<sup>e</sup> have and all friends  
who may inquire after me, let me hear  
from thee, direct to Stephen Cressy at Colchester  
to be sent forwards who take care many  
sugarake love is to thee Q. H. E. H. m. C.
