After our Love unto thee, & my dear wife Remembred
by thee you may know I am heere, & am constrained to
stay by reason of a great flood, but I have vnder the
Land there I was upon called Populations be for
Orithons Island for which I have got an order of
the Governor, and I have procured house room a little
up the Creek betwixt Orithons Island at one
small Brittain, where I would have you to make up to,
for I do not see how I can get downe before you
from past Newcastle, & so shall write of you, the
Governor is of a mind y^e make may discharge you
but of five shillings you nor any of you need pay him
being it was left to us, & hee sound forring, he has
procured me 6 men to help me for a week or so
words of two of them must be sawyers w^{ch} you
loy is with me, & have beene 2 night hee & slept
by water also, altho hee be within 6 miles of home his
famaly is well so is h^e: severall friends heere are
glad of our Coming y^e plantation w^{ch} you will may
