I Came to Danzig and had a blessed heavenly meeting
with friends, and the Lords power was over all
and friends hearts were filled with the love of
god, the next day, being tho: 23: I had another blessed
meeting, and the Lord did wonderfully a year
amongst us, glory to his name for our ^{good fornicia} I had,
they had a mens meeting: tho: 24: and things did
open in mee to them, showing them, those
y^elains, and fornicia, in the Church of Christ
and they woman friends, said why may not
we, have a meeting, as well as the men
I said I knowe no Cause, but you may as
well as the men, for the widow glad, and
in a short time they got by a yearly meeting,
I also proposed to frederick flat friends, to
meet with hamburgs friends, twice in the
year, which would be of great fornicia, which
was performed, at that time, I travelled with
the governor of stedlin, and some other great men
to a Citie called wiffmoor, with whom, I had
good fornicia, after, we had, had some shaves, diff
in three days and three nights, when we came
to wiffmoor, he had me, to the governor, of that
y^eland, who did treat mee very kindly, the next
day, I came to Lubite, from thence of frederick flat

as I was travelling in Ireland betwixt Canon and
and Castol in the County of Armagh, and a
friend being with me, we saw a great Comy
of sheep, in a field, near the way we
was to ride, I said to the friend, what is all
them sheep, Doomy, he said I suppose the are at
Mass, and as I came towards the field a waight
fell upon me, and the being all fright, I asyed to
pass by them, till I could get no further, then I
went a stand, and the friend saw me stand, he rane
back again, I told him I must go to them, he
said, we cannot get over the hedge, for it was
a thick thorne hedge, we ride back again a little
and I saw a plain, and turned my horse to it and
over he went without whip or spur, and I saw
the priest when I came into the field, but before I came
to them, he had taken his white Cross of his back and
brast, so that I could not know him, I came up to
them, as I fell upon my horse, said pray the Lord god of
heaven and earth, and give glory to his name, for the
honor of his Judgment is come, and a coming upon all
the workers of iniquity, therefore present and
form unto the Lord, before the doare of marys breast
and words to this purpose, and the then gathered
about me, and I was privileged in the midst of them
and when I was clear I turned my horse to come, a
way, and they opened a way for me, and took of
their hats, and bid me fare well and wish me
a good journey, I think they might be 4: or 5: hundred
and I did not hear one fourth word from them
