July 27<sup>th</sup>

Dear Mother -  
 We got your letters about  
 two days ago. It seems very  
 trying to think of Miss Fuller  
 teaching the kids, I expect she  
 is a good teacher in her old age,  
 please remember me to her.  
 We are having a very jolly time  
 here the place belongs to Mr  
 Fisher and they live  
 here as a rule but we have  
 had a long day or two  
 on business  
 Give my love to  
 all the folks  
 I am

they have a very jolly little  
boat on it, we bathe every  
morning and Bill is teaching

so it is not dull out here.

I suppose Phyllis & Clara are  
back from Brussels. We  
were so sorry Tichy had

We are going to send you a  
photo of the little house we  
were in at first, I expect you  
will get it soon after this  
letter, Mrs. Fell took it for  
us, she is really a very good  
photographer I should think.  
I am so glad H. W. is getting  
along all right, I wrote to Robin  
the other day but have <sup>not</sup> had  
any answer yet. You may  
be sure we shall write to  
Maurice sometimes, he must



be rather lonely now & then  
quite alone except for strangers,  
you see it is different for us,  
and at present we are all  
having a very good time.  
Everybody who has seen our  
house at Harcoossee says it  
is very nice, one fellow has  
copied it already and building  
another just like it; I shall  
not be sorry when we are settled  
in it only most people living  
in Florida can move at a days  
notice as every one sells his  
place if he can get his price,  
so it makes a great deal of
