Narcossee

Nov. 2<sup>nd</sup>

My dear Maama

Bill & I are going in to  
Missimunc tomorrow I hope,  
M<sup>rs</sup> Daniel is coming out on  
Wednesday and we are going in  
to meet her. Fancy I have not  
been out of Narcossee since  
the middle of August, when we  
came out. I gave Herbert your  
message when I wrote next to  
him, & I expect you will hear  
from him very soon, we never  
see him now, although he is  
only about thirty or forty miles off  
it takes a whole day to get there  
and he is pretty busy I believe  
at the Daniels. Narcossee is  
just booming along as they  
say, the boarding house is crowded

out with fellows and an American  
came out last week and bought  
a good deal of land and said  
he was going to put up a hardware  
store, which would be a very  
good thing as at present the  
nearest is Missinuncie, he talked  
of starting other things as well,  
so I hope the place is going to  
start. I really believe I have got  
some chickens at last, Bill said  
somebody in the camp had got  
hold of some for me - Bill  
borrowed a horse & waggon  
yesterday, so we drove off to Kunnay  
-mede (W. Watson's place) it is  
on the same lake only about 2  
miles off, there will be a lovely  
drive, by the edge of the lake all  
the way there directly, that will  
be awfully jolly, there is a very  
nice hotel at Kunnay mede, that

will be finished this winter,  
and Mr Watson has got some  
scheme of an Agricultural  
Coll for young fellows to learn  
orange growing etc, at present he  
has one pupil an awful ass,  
I certainly think the whole thing  
rather a fraud but I daresay  
some people might like it -

Old Mrs Thompson had a nigger  
meeting yesterday I believe, she  
will put her foot in it directly, for  
the niggers here are far from  
being ignorant of the Bible and  
have got ~~to~~ as much idea of  
religion as she has, I hate the  
old woman, but her daughter  
is very nice - The boat will not  
be running for some time yet  
so don't expect letters regularly,  
they have applied for a post office  
at Narcoossee and I believe it

is talked of, but I don't suppose it will actually be working for another year, they always take such a ~~time~~ over that sort of thing. There is to be a dance in Mississinewa on Thursday, but I don't think we will go, ~~for~~ none of the Karcossee fellows are going so it would not be much fun for me. Please give my love to Bertha & Co, I really have not time to write to them today, I shall think of them on the 5<sup>th</sup>. With love from both of us
