Missimmee, Fla., March 21st 1888

My dear Mamma

We came in from Narcossee last Friday evening in the buggy, but Bill & Herbert both had to go back to Narcossee today, but will be out again tonight, we are going on to Beland on Wednesday most likely. You will be glad to know that Rose's box of things has arrived alright and Mr. Haine has sent off the parcel from Richmond so I hope everything will be quite ready. Mr. Davis's sister had a little boy last week, she had been very ill and I am not surprised it came so much too soon. I am still perfectly well in every way, but very glad it is nearly over at last. Bill told me he had said ~~it~~ he would cable to you, but I don't see any reason for the expense if I am perfectly well and alright, so do not be surprised if you do not hear before you get a letter telling you

all about it, of course if anything were to go wrong he
would let you know at once, but that is very unlikely.
This place is very cheerful just now, quite crowded with
English people, the Plimsoles are still here, M^r. is very
nice, I was talking to her for a long time today and
one or two others, all very pleasant. - Fancy the Oregon
going to the bottom, I am sure a whole heap of your
letters are gone with her too, for I have had no letters
for nearly three weeks except from Clara & Georgie.
Herbert is much more cheerful than he was and is
full of money making schemes, like his old self
again. How is every body, I mean to write a lot to
them all when I get to Belandé, I never have any
time in Harcoossee. I was so sorry to leave the grove,
in another month the little trees will have quantities
of blossom, one tree is covered already, but it is not
open yet. - With best love to all the others.
