Kissimmee, Fla., Saturday 1886

My dear Mama

I am sending you Rubie's photo at least I will as soon as I get the one I want you to have, she has been taken in two positions and the nicest has not come back yet. I have come in here for good now, I cannot get any sort of servants so I cannot go back to Marcoossee; but Bill is Capt. of the "Colonist" a very nice steamer here, so I shall live here altogether, he has to live on the boat almost all the time, he comes up for an hour or two every evening and sometimes can stay all night, but has to be down on the boat by six a.m., it would be very dull without Rubie, but I hope to be out with the Colonist very often, it is very expensive

living here, I am afraid to live in a house
by myself in here, it is not quiet like
Karcossee. Thank you so much for the paper
with the account of Alice's wedding, what
lovely presents she had. Herbert is living on
the boat with Bill at present, he sends his
love to you. Did I tell you Rubie has two
teeth. It is very kind of you to think of sending
me a paper, I think if it is quite the same
to you I would like "The Lady" a weekly fashion
& gossip paper, why won't you take it in
yourself and send it to me afterwards I am
sure you would like it, W. G. sends it to
me sometimes. I have never received
Pge Thavassi's books that you sent, but I
have a copy with the three bound together,
the Thompsons gave it to me before they
left Kuncymede. With best love from us.
