My dear Grandma

I think, it is some time since I wrote to you. Bill went to Orlando last week, leaving Herbert & myself in charge of the little house; he found at once that it was no use our thinking of getting a furnished cottage or rooms, so in preference to going to an hotel for the winter in April, we are going to board with a Dr. Matthews & his wife

who live in Orlandos, he is supposed  
to be the best doctor there, but of  
course as we knew Mullius  
before, we had made arrangements  
with Mullius to attend me,  
which arrangements now have  
had to be altered, for Matthews  
will of course look after me  
now, Bill has settled it all  
with Dr Mullius and I hope he  
will not be offended, for I like the  
old man myself, but you know  
how touchy doctors are. Matthews  
asked Bill several questions  
about me, which Mullius never  
did, and we find that our  
calculations (as usual) are

all wrong, and it is to be  
expected on the 12<sup>th</sup> of April  
and not the 24<sup>th</sup> as we before  
thought, so we are going to  
Belauds about March 20<sup>th</sup>.  
I am expecting <sup>to</sup> hear of Mr. Hainey's  
arrival every day, I shall be
