Jan 6<sup>th</sup>

My dear Mamma

I really ~~forget~~ when I wrote  
last any way I daresay you won't  
mind hearing again. I am glad  
to say that the money came out  
at last on Jan 2<sup>d</sup>, as far I have not  
heard from Lou about it. I am  
very anxious to hear how Herbert  
got on during the voyage, we have  
not had any letters from you at  
home since he got back, but I  
think it is the fault of the mails  
I daresay it is rough and the  
ships are late. There was a very

decent travelling circus here this week, we took baby in the afternoon but although she seemed to enjoy it, she went to sleep about half way through. There is a lot of chicken pox in town at present but I don't let any child at all come near Rubie so I hope she will be safe. We have had quite cold weather for a week, and Rubie looks so nice & warm in the pelisse Georgie sent her, there is not such a nice healthy fat baby as her in the whole place, everybody notices her. We went to The Popsical on New Years night; there was a kind of party, not much fun though



no dancing or anything. You  
will be glad to ~~hear~~ hear that Nubie  
seems perfectly well at last, she  
does everything now just like any  
other baby, she is just beginning  
to tell me now too in time to  
be clean ~~or~~ about it; Mrs Stewart  
an Irish lady at the Tropical  
told me she was very late in her

wite I did not know how to
