WINTER ADDRESS: Woodstock, Conn.

July 9, 1928

Miss Clara Louise Guild  
Winter Park, Florida

Dear Miss Guild:

I have for the moment forgotten your Vermont address, hence this letter is going to Winter Park to be forwarded.

I want to tell you first what a thoroughly successful meeting of the alumni we had in Boston on June 28. It followed the commencement of Boston University where President Holt spoke to an enthusiastic audience of over 18,000 people, and received with President Lovell of Harvard, an honorary degree.

But we were sorry that you and your sister could not be present because I always think of you in connection with our alumni at Boston.

President Holt and I have our office settled here in Woodstock for the summer, where we are busily engaged working on the endowment fund.

I hope the colony in Vermont is as interesting as ever, and I hope I may have the pleasure of hearing from you when there is a spare moment. Please give my best regards to Mr. & Mrs. Brewer.
