## Happy Holidays from the UCF Libraries!

It's definitely the holiday season here at UCF! If you would like learn more about various holidays around the world (or in your own neighborhood), try searching the Library database *CREDO reference*.

*CREDO reference* is listed alphabetically on the Articles & Databases page: <http://library.ucf.edu/Databases>. Search using the terms "world holidays" and then select "*Holidays, Festivals, and Celebrations of the World Dictionary*". Some examples are: **Chester Greenwood Day**: the first Saturday in December residents of Farmington, Maine celebrate the invention of earmuffs with a parade and foot race; **Shalako**: in late November or early December the Zuni tribe of New Mexico celebrate to commemorate the dead and offer prayers for good health and good weather in the coming year; and **Night of the Radishes**: on December 23 residents of Oaxaca, Mexico celebrate the introduction of the radish to the Americas by carving radishes into elaborate sculptures and then close out the festivities with fireworks.
