Subject: Annual Report, 1971/72

As requested in your memorandum of June 28, 1972, I am noting below the highlights of activities in the library and instructional media during the past fiscal year. As you can appreciate, the greatest difficulty was in providing a reasonably meaningful report within the space limitations.

The library and instructional media have continued their high level of service to the university community. Nearly 115,000 books were checked out by faculty and students, and answers to more than 12,000 reference questions were provided by library staff members. Equipment check out transactions from instructional media numbered more than 7,500 and requests for graphic and photographic services continued to grow at a high rate. Instructional media moved into new quarters which helped to alleviate at least partially the cramped working conditions. The Current Awareness List published by the Readers Services Division of the library now goes to more than 600 readers, and continues to receive high praise from educators throughout Florida and the Southeast.
