## Seeing dots on our shelves?

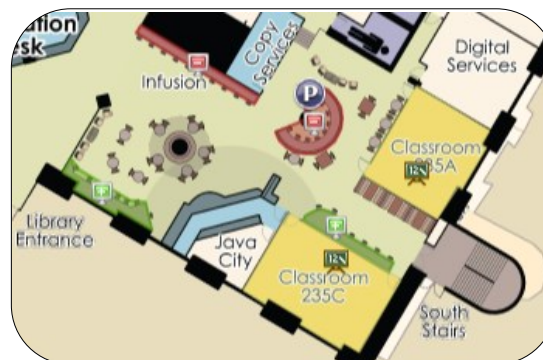
Have you noticed the **Green / Yellow / Red** dots on the library books?
